The Small Farmer's Journal welcomes you to the 2010 HORSEDRAWN AUCTION and SWAP MEET to be held at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds at 430 Fairgrounds Road in Madras, Oregon. We welcome the public to display, advertise, sell, buy or just enjoy those things related to the horse and mule in harness. **There will be a \$5 parking fee per vehicle for the entire event.**

BIDDER'S NUMBERS / SEATING A 3% BUYER'S PREMIUM unless you pay by cash or check.

Please come to the Auction office at the fairgrounds to obtain your bidder's numbers. You must have two positive I.D.s. If you lose your bidding number, you will still be held responsible for the items bought on it. We accept personal checks with proper I.D. or cash, cashier checks or money orders, VISA, MasterCard and Discover as payment. Notice to our Canadian buyers: We will accept Canadian checks payable in U.S. funds.

AUCTION

ALL items to be sold at auction (including animals) must be on the premises and checked in no later than 8:00 p.m. Wednesday night, April 14th.

Once again you are invited to consign draft horses, mules, carriage horses and driving ponies, as well as good usable or restorable horsedrawn equipment items including carriages, wagons, harness, collars, farm implements, etc. The auction portion of the event is THREE full days (Thursday, Friday, & Saturday). We want to hold the focus of the event to work animals & horsedrawn items. If you are uncertain whether or not your items 'fit the bill' we'd be glad to discuss it with you.

New This Year: PREMIERE SELECT SALES Horses - Carriages. At the beginning of the Carriage and Horse Auctions we will be offering a Premiere Select Sale of juried consignments. In order to be eligible you will need to submit up to a three minute video clip of your animals showcasing condition and training, or four photos each of horsedrawn vehicles. If your consignment is deemed worthy by the jury you will be entered in the **select sale** and expected to pay a \$50 per consignment entry fee which will give you a guaranteed pre-assigned position in the selling order PLUS accelerated showcased advertising. The deadline for entry in the Premiere Select Sale portion is March 10th

Also featuring a separated **Antique Paper and Glass Auction** for consignments of old books, manuals, advertising art, ceramics and glassware related to farming and horsedrawn themes. This will occur Friday evening in one of the exhibition buildings.

ALL FEES and paperwork **MUST** be received by the SFJ office before April 5. No exceptions. Animals that have not been pre-registered and paid for will not be accepted for auction.

The auctioneers and event management reserve the right to make specific judgement calls on consignment suitability. If you have merchandise deemed unsuitable for the auction portion, we encourage you to rent a swap meet space to display and sell those items. Please see consignment notifications for regulations. All purchased items must be removed from the Fairgrounds by Sunday, April 18.

SMALL FARM TRADE FAIR & SWAP MEET plus RV

Whether or not you consign to the auction, you are invited to rent a swap meet space to display and/or sell privately. To guarantee reserved spaces, you must pay in advance. We are expanding the swap meet and encourage these important segments:

Horse drawn items including vehicles, implements, tack, etc. Small farm goods, services, organizations, including seeds, preserves, and tools. Green living and self-sufficiency tools. Arts & crafts including blacksmiths, harness makers, wheelwrights, quilters, furniture makers, etc., and antiques including hand tools, and furniture.

Outside spaces (you provide cover, tables, etc.) are \$175 for 10' x 20' \$100 for 10' x 10'

Indoor spaces (you provide tables, etc.) are \$225 for 10' x 10'

Tables are available to rent for inside vendor use at \$5/each

Electricity is also available for an additional \$15

With national display advertising and mailings we expect many new buyers and sellers to attend. This is a good reason for you to let us know NOW just what you may be bringing to the auction and how many swap meet spaces you want.

There are ample indoor facilities, an enclosed arena and shower/restroom facilities are available for campers.

Also, dry overnight RV parking and tent camping spots (with no hook-ups) are available at the fairgrounds for \$15 per night. Full-hook-up RV facilities for \$25 per night are available and reservations are recommended to assure availability.

We'd like to know what you intend to bring to put in the auction. The more information you share with us the better job we can do to get interested buyers in attendance. If you have any photos of your animals, please share them with us. If you need the photos returned, include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

The PREMIERE SELECT portion of the auction requires a three minute video clip of your animal(s) showcasing condition and training. If your consignment is deemed worthy by the jury you will be entered in the Select Sale and expected to pay a \$50 per consignment entry fee which will give you a guaranteed pre-assigned position in the selling order PLUS accelerated showcased advertising. The deadline for entry in the Premiere Select Sale portion is March 10th. All horses will be auctioned Friday, April 16th.

All livestock auctioned will be billed at 10% commission.

ALL FEES and paperwork MUST be at the SFJ office before April 5. No animal accepted without this. No exceptions. ANY UNSOLD ANIMALS REMAINING ON THE GROUNDS AFTER SATURDAY NIGHT WILL BE SUBJECT TO BOARD AND HANDLING CHARGES.

THERE WILL BE A **NONREFUNDABLE CONSIGNMENT FEE OF \$25 FOR EACH HORSE, PONY, MULE OR OX ENTERED IN THE FRIDAY DRAFT HORSE AUCTION.** SEND YOUR FEE WITH THIS CONSIGNMENT FORM. *If you "no-show," this fee will not be refunded.* Please note: Livestock & items for the auction need to be brought to the Jefferson County Fairgrounds, Madras, Oregon, no later than Wednesday 4/14/10 8pm. If you have delivery problems, special needs or must bring items early, please get in touch with us before April 5. **IMPORTANT - NO EQUIPMENT or ANIMAL CONSIGNMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8 PM 4/14/10!** When your animals are checked in at the fairgrounds they will be tagged, identified, and cataloged on a consignment contract and you will be required to sign the form at that time. Your signature empowers us to sell your animals at auction. Your copy of that contract will constitute your receipt. If you have concerns about minimum values, we will be happy to discuss with you what we THINK your items/ animals might bring at auction and/or their fair market value. If you choose to "no-sale" a consigned animal there will be a "no-sale" fee of \$75.00 and the no-sale must be preapproved.
CONSIGNORS CHECKS will be mailed out 15 days after date of sale.

HORSE SALE RULES

NEW THIS YEAR: Premiere Select Sales see additional information on website and on Consignment forms

ALL FEES and paperwork **MUST** be received by the SFJ office before April 5. No exceptions. **ANY UNSOLD ANIMALS REMAINING ON THE GROUNDS AFTER SATURDAY NIGHT WILL BE SUBJECT TO BOARD AND HANDLING CHARGES.**

Please find below a list of the paperwork you will be required to have for each horse you have consigned, as well as some other pertinent bits of information. We hope that this information will help us have a smooth running and safe horse sale.

REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES, PONIES AND MULES:

1. Negative EIA ("Coggins" or ELISA) Test papers: Horses must be tested within 6 months prior to date of sale. NOTE: Please have separate papers for EACH animal as they may not be purchased by the same person.

2. Current vaccinations: PLEASE have proof that your horse's West Nile Virus vaccinations are up to date! Flu & Rhino should be given not less than two weeks prior to auction.

ALSO REQUIRED FOR HORSES, PONIES AND MULES COMING FROM OUTSIDE THE STATE OF OREGON

1. **Current Interstate Health Certificate.** Again: Please have a separate certificate for each animal. (Photocopies are acceptable.)

ALSO REQUIRED FOR HORSES COMING FROM INSIDE THE STATE OF OREGON

1. **Completed Transportation Slip** (Blank slips may be obtained from your brand inspector.)

REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERED HORSES (If you do not have the following paperwork, your horses will be sold as grade horses. NO EXCEPTIONS!!)

A. **Original Certificate of Registration** *showing the seller as the recorded owner of the animal.* (No horse will be sold as "registered" without the ORIGINAL certificate. NOTE: Horses will be checked to make sure that they match the description on the papers.)

B. **Signed Transfer Application.** If the transfer is not up to date, any late fees or penalties will be charged to the seller, and deducted from his/her check.

C. **Breeding Certificate.** Mares sold as "In Foal" must be accompanied by a breeding certificate signed by the stallion owner.

ALL HORSES CONSIGNED MUST BE HALTER BROKE & MANAGEABLE! A serviceable halter & lead must be left with the horse or new ones will be purchased and the price will be deducted from the seller's check.

Registration Transfers. As per the rules of most registries, the fees for transfer of registration papers is the responsibility of the seller. These fees will be deducted from the seller's check.

Checking in. Horses may be checked in on the following dates and times: Tuesday, April 13th from 8 am until 8 p.m.; Wednesday, April 14 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. **All animals MUST be checked in no later than 8 p.m. Wednesday, April 14th.** (You will need to check in at the horse pen area with the SFJ Horse Sale staff.)

Pens. A fee of \$5 per animal will be charged upon arrival. Pens are stout, ample rodeo stock pens. All horses must be housed in the sale pen area. You may not leave horses tied to or inside of trailers.

Feed and Water. *YOU will be responsible for feeding & watering your own animals until they sell.* You will need to bring your own water buckets and hay adequate for the entire weekend.

Stallions. Please let us know if you are bringing a stallion so that we can arrange for any special stabling needs ahead of time.

Consignment Fees & Commission. There is a nonrefundable consignment fee of \$25 per animal which goes towards the Vet inspection. The commission on all animals is 10%. A fee of \$75 will be charged, in addition to the consignment fee, for all "No Sales." Once your horse is consigned it MUST go through the auction.

Notice on Hitching. The fairgrounds will be available for use in showing your horses to the public. Forecarts and a wagon will also be available. Horses must stay in the designated areas. **Drivers and owners are liable for any and all injuries or damages caused by their horses. No horses allowed on the grass.**

Guarantees: Each consignor will be totally responsible for guarantees made on his animals. The guarantees and soundness of each animal are those announced at the moment of sale. Absolutely no guarantee or warranty will be expressed or implied by the auctioneers or ringmen.

ALL HORSE FEES MUST BE PAID FOR IN ADVANCE (received no later than APRIL 5, 2010)
